

MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

GRADES 6-8

In order to help your student stay organized this year please consider buying different colored notebooks or binders for each subject. That would be a great start for a well-organized year!

1-inch binder for Math

1 package of ¼ inch graph paper

2 thick dry erase markers and a pack of thin dry erase markers

1-inch binder for Science

1 ½ inch binder for Language Arts (Incoming 6th and 8th graders may use the same binder as last year that was collected at the end of the year.)

1-inch binder for Spanish

1-inch binder for Religion

Enough binder paper for each (1/2 pack per binder is a good start)

Dividers with pockets for each binder – 5 sets total

We recommend either MEAD or the Target brand of notebook. They have plastic covers that are more durable and will last the entire year.

3 - subject notebook with pocket folders/dividers included for Social Studies

A flash drive with student's name or initials on it

Pencils (**without a permanent desk pencils are easily lost**)

A pencil case

Pens – both red and blue/black

A package of colored pencils

Erasers

A pack of glue sticks

A highlighter

5 packs of index cards

1 package of binder rings for vocabulary and PJAS

2 jars of rubber cement (not needed until science project work)

The following items are for the entire middle school to use:

All middle school students need to bring 3 boxes of tissues

6th graders – 2 rolls of paper towels

7th graders – a container of Clorox wipes

8th graders – a large bottle of hand sanitizer

For art class, please send the following items in a Ziploc bag with the student's name:

- Glue stick
- Fine black sharpie marker
- Eraser

For Music, Computer, and Health class:

- a folder with pockets for each
- earbuds for computer class
- 1 subject notebook for Health class
